TENDER NOTICE

The Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) is a State Corporation established under the Ministry of Roads by the Kenya Roads Act, 2007 with the core mandate of Management, Development, Rehabilitation and Maintenance of all Public Roads in Cities and Municipalities in Kenya except where those Roads are National Roads.

As a leading Government Agency with the above mandate, KURA wishes to invite bids from eligible construction companies for road works as described below. Interested bidders MUST be registered with the National Construction Authority (NCA) in the road works categories indicated below:-

Box 41727 - 00100, NAIROBI, Tel: 254 - 020 – 8013844 upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Kshs. 1,000 (Kenya Shillings One Thousand Only) for each document in form of a Bankers Cheque payable to the Kenya Urban Roads Authority. Bidders will be required to attach a copy of an official receipt to the bid document when submitting as proof of payment. For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the Manager Procurement office immediately after the site visit and before submitting the documents. No bidder shall be

awarded more than one contract.

Qualification for Tendering (Mandatory)

The bidders are expected to include the following in their bids:-

- (a) Certified copy of Certificate of Registration/Incorporation;
- (b) Certified copy of valid Registration Certificate with the National Construction Authority in the stated category and Practicing license from National Construction Authority;(will be verified from NCA website);
- (c) Copy of Valid Tax Compliance Certificate (will be verified on the KRA TCC Checker);
- (d) Certified copy of recent CR12 form -(12 months) from Registrar of Companies ;
- (e) Bidders shall serialize all pages for each tender document submitted; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified.

Note:

- The certification of documents shall be original and executed by a Commissioner for Oaths; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified
- To enhance equity, bidders shall bid for a maximum of two (2) tenders pursuant to this tender notice
- Bidders with history of non-performance in KURA, KERRA, KENHA or MOTIHUD e.g. failure to complete the projects within the contract period, termination of contract or having been issued with a notice of termination are ineligible to bid.

Other Requirements are as specified in the respective tender documents.

The Criteria of Evaluation of Bids

The criteria shall be as described in the tender documents and this tender notice.

Description of Works

The description and scope of works is as described in the tender documents.
