As a leading Government Agency with the above mandate, KURA wishes to invite bids from eligible companies as described below to be funded through Fuel Levy Fund (RMLF)

Bidders may examine and obtain detailed tender documents during normal working hours, from Supply Chain Department at KURA headquarters, Situated along at IKM PLACE, 5th Ngong Avenue, Opposite Bishops Gate, 4th Floor, P. Box 41727 - 00100, NAIROBI, Tel: 254 - 020 – 8013844 upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Kshs. 1,000 (Kenya Shillings One Thousand Only) for each document in form of a Bankers Cheque payable to the Kenya Urban Roads Authority. The same information may be accessed in our website at www.kura.go.ke/tenders. Bidders will be required to attach a copy of an official receipt to the bid document when submitting as proof of payment. For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the Supply Chain Department at KURA headquarters, immediately after the pre-bid conference meeting and before submitting the documents.

Qualification for Tendering (Mandatory)

The bidders are expected to include the following in their bids:-

- (a) Certified copy of Certificate of Registration/Incorporation
- (b) Certified copy of Valid Tax Compliance Certificate
- (c) Certified copy of recent CR12 form -(12 months) from Registrar of Companies
- (d) Bidder shall serialize all the pages for each tender document submitted; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified.

Note:

Certification of the documents shall be original and executed by a **Commissioner for Oaths**.

Description of Works

Prices quoted should include all taxes and must be expressed in Kenya Shillings and shall remain valid for a period of 120 days from the date of tender opening.


