### TENDER NOTICE

The Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) is a State Corporation in the Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure (MOTI); established under Kenya Roads Act, 2007 with the core mandate of management, development, rehabilitation and maintenance of national urban road network. As a leading Government Agency with the above mandate, KURA wishes to invite bids using the restricted tendering method pursuant to section 102(1d) of the PPADA, 2015 from eligible construction companies for road works as described below to be funded through Road Maintenance Levy Fund (RMLF).

Interested bidders **MUST** be registered with the National Construction Authority (NCA) road works categories as indicated below:-

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and inspect tender documents from the Regional Supply Chain Management Department, Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) during normal working hours.

A complete set of tender documents may be obtained by interested tenderers from the Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) website: [www.kura.go.ke](http://www.kura.go.ke) or [www.suppliers.treasury.go.ke](http://www.suppliers.treasury.go.ke). free of charge OR from the Regional Supply Chain Management Department, upon payment of a non- refundable fee of KShs. 1,000 (One thousand shillings only) in form of banker's Cheque only payable to Kenya Urban Roads Authority.

Bidders will be required to attach a copy of an official receipt to the bid document when submitting as proof of payment. For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the Regional Supply Chain Management Department immediately after the site visit and before submitting the documents.

#### Qualification for Tendering (Mandatory)

The bidders are expected to include the following in their bids:-

1. Certified copy of Certificate of incorporation
2. Certified Copy of a valid Registration certificate with National Construction Authority (NCA) in the relevant category and Practicing Licenses from NCA.
3. Copy of Valid Tax Compliance Certificate (will be verified on the KRA TCC Checker)
4. Certified copy of CR 12 form (Recent within 12 months) that has been generated from the Business registry, failure of which leads to disqualification.
5. Bidders shall **serialize** all pages for each tender document submitted; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified.

#### Note:

- Certification of documents shall be original and executed by a Commissioner for Oaths.

- For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the **Regional Supply Chain Management Department** immediately after the site visit and before submitting the documents. **Failure to which bidders shall be disqualified.**
- Due diligence shall be carried out on the documents submitted by the bidder from the source of origin and the outcome shall be used for recommendation or disqualification.

**Other Requirements** are as specified in the respective tender documents.

**The Criteria of Evaluation of Bids**

**Description of Works**

The description and scope of works is as described in the tender documents.

Prices quoted should include all taxes and must be expressed in Kenya Shillings and shall remain valid for a period of **90 days** from the date of tender opening.
