TENDER NOTICE

The Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) is a State Corporation in the Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure, Housing and Urban Development (MOTIHUD); established under Kenya Roads Act, 2007 with the core mandate of management, development, rehabilitation and maintenance of national urban road network. As a leading Government Agency with the above mandate, KURA wishes to invite bids from eligible construction companies for road works as described below to be funded through Fuel Levy Fund (RMLF).

Interested bidders **MUST** be registered with the National Construction Authority (NCA) road works categories as indicated below:-

Bidders may examine and obtain detailed tender documents during normal working hours, from the **Regional Supply Chain Management Office**, upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Kshs. 1,000 (Kenya Shillings One Thousand Only) for each document in form of a **Banker's Cheque** payable to the Kenya Urban Roads Authority. The same information may be accessed in websites at www.kura.go.ke/tenders, <https://supplier.treasury.go.ke>. Bidders will be required to attach a copy of an official receipt to the bid document when submitting as proof of payment. For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the Regional Supply Chain Management Office, immediately after the site visit and before submitting the documents.

Qualification for Tendering (Mandatory)

The bidders are expected to include the following in their bids:-

- Certified Copy** of Certificate of incorporation;
- Certified Copy** of VALID Registration Certificate with the National Construction Authority in the categories specified above and Valid Practicing License;
- A copy** of VALID Tax Compliance Certificate (Will be verified on the KRA TCC Checker);
- Certified Copy** of RECENT CR12 form generated through the system -(12 months) from Registrar of Companies; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified;
- Bidders **shall serialize** all pages for each tender document submitted; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified;
- Certified copy** of a valid certificate of registration in a target group issued by the National Treasury or the respective County Treasury in the relevant category (**Youth**).

Note:

- ❖ Certification of documents shall be original and executed by a **Commissioner for Oaths**.
- ❖ Submitted Documents by the Bidders **shall be subjected to Due Diligence** from the originating sources and shall be used for recommendation or disqualifications depending on the outcome;
- ❖ For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the Supply Chain Management office of Respective Regions immediately after the site visit and before submitting the documents. **Failure to which bidders shall be disqualified.**

The criteria of evaluation of bids

The criteria shall be as described in the tender documents.

Description of Works

The description and scope of works is as described in the tender documents.

Bidders are required to be represented by a Technical person with Civil Engineering background who should come with a National Identification card or Passport and an introduction letter from the bidder.

Bid Price and validity

Prices quoted should include all taxes and must be expressed in Kenya Shillings and shall remain valid for a period of 90 days from the date of tender opening.

Bid Submission
