RESTRICTED TENDER NOTICE

The Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) is a State Corporation in the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, Housing, Urban Development and Public Works; established under Kenya Roads Act, 2007 with the core mandate of Management, Development, Rehabilitation and Maintenance of National Urban Road Network. As a leading Government Agency with the above mandate, KURA wishes to state its intention to procure the works using **restricted tendering method pursuant to section 102(1d) of the PPADA, 2015** from eligible construction companies for road works as described below to be funded through Road Maintenance Levy Fund (RMLF).

Interested bidders **MUST** be registered with the National Construction Authority (NCA) road works categories as indicated below:-

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and inspect tender documents from the **HQ Supply Chain Management Department, Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA)** during normal working hours.

A complete set of tender documents may be obtained by interested tenderers from the Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) website: www.kura.go.ke free of charge OR from the **HQ Supply Chain Management Department**, upon payment of a non-refundable fee of KShs. 1,000 (One thousand shillings only) in form of **banker's Cheque only** payable to Kenya Urban Roads Authority.

Bidders will be required to attach a copy of an official receipt to the bid document when submitting as proof of payment. For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the **HQ Supply Chain Management Department** immediately after the site visit and before submitting the documents.

Qualification for Tendering (Mandatory)

The bidders are expected to include the following in their bids:-

- **Certified Copy** of Certificate of incorporation;
- **Certified Copy** of VALID Registration Certificate with the National Construction Authority in the categories specified above and Valid Practicing License;
- A copy of VALID Tax Compliance Certificate (Will be verified on the KRA TCC Checker);
- **Certified Copy** of RECENT CR12 form generated through the system -(12 months before opening date) from Registrar of Companies; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified;
- Bidders shall **sequentially serialize** all pages for each tender document submitted; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified;

Note:

- Certification of documents shall be original and executed by a **Commissioner for Oaths or issuing institution**.
- Submitted Documents by the Bidders shall be subjected to **Due Diligence** from the originating sources and shall be used for recommendation or disqualifications depending on the outcome;

- All interested bidders are required to continually check the KURA website www.kura.go.ke/tenders for any tender addenda or clarification that may arise before the submission date.

Other Requirements are as specified in the respective tender documents.

The criteria of evaluation of bids

The criteria shall be as described in the tender document.

Description of Works

The description and scope of works is as described in the tender document.

Mandatory site visits/Pre-bid meeting

Bidders are advised to appraise themselves on site conditions before bidding and fill the form provided.

The authority shall not organize the site visit, however Bidders are advised to make their arrangement to visit the site.

Prices quoted should include all taxes and must be expressed in Kenya Shillings and shall remain valid for a period of 90 days from the date of tender opening.
