The Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) is a State Corporation established under the Ministry of Roads and infrastructure (MOTI); established under Kenya Roads Act, 2007 with a core mandate of Management, Development, Rehabilitation and Maintenance of National Urban Road network. As a leading Government Agency with the above mandate, KURA wishes to invite bids from eligible companies as described below to be funded through Road Maintenance Levy Fund (RMLF)

Bidders may examine and obtain detailed tender documents during normal working hours, from the Supply Chain Management Office on Ground floor Barabara plaza, Block D, upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Kshs. 1,000 (Kenya Shillings One Thousand Only) for each document in form of a Banker's Cheque payable to the Kenya Urban Roads Authority. The same information may be accessed in websites at www.kura.go.ke/tenders and www.tenders.go.ke. Bidders will be required to attach a copy of an official receipt to the bid document when submitting as proof of payment. For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the Supply Chain Department at KURA headquarters, before submitting the documents.

Qualification for Tendering (Mandatory)

The bidders are expected to include the following in their bids:-

- Certified copy of Certificate of Registration/Incorporation
- Certified copy of Valid Tax Compliance Certificate
- Certified copy of recent CR12 form -(6 months) from Registrar of Companies
- Certified copy of registration certificate with Energy Petroleum Regulatory Authority Category 1
- Certified copy of registration certificate with the National Construction Authority Category 1 Electrical and 3 Road contractor
- Certified copy of registration certificate with the Communication Authority as a telecommunications contractor.
- Certified copy of accreditation certificate with ICT Authority in category 5.
- Bidders shall serialize all the pages for each tender document submitted; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified.

Note:

- ❖ Certification of the documents shall be original and executed by a Commissioner for Oaths.
- ❖ All interested bidders are required to continually check the KURA website www.kura.go.ke/tenders for any tender addenda or clarification that may arise before the submission date.
- ❖ COVID 19 Guidelines from the Ministry Of Health shall apply during the tendering process.

The Criteria of Evaluation of Bids

Bid validity

Prices quoted should include all taxes and must be expressed in Kenya Shillings and shall remain valid for a period of 140 days from the date of tender opening.
