TENDER NOTICE

The Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) is a State Corporation in the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, Housing, Urban Development and Public Works; established under Kenya Roads Act, 2007 with the core mandate of Management, Development, Rehabilitation and Maintenance of National Urban Road Network. As a leading Government Agency with the above mandate, KURA wishes to invite bids from eligible construction companies for road works as described below to be funded through Fuel Levy Fund (RMLF).

Interested bidders MUST be registered with the National Construction Authority in various categories as indicated below:-

Bidders may examine and obtain detailed tender documents during normal working hours, from the **North Eastern Supply Chain office**, upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Kshs. 1,000** (Kenya Shillings One Thousand Only) for each document in form of a **Banker's Cheque** payable to the **Kenya Urban Roads Authority**. The same information may be accessed in websites at www.kura.go.ke/tenders, www.tenders.go.ke. **Bidders will be required to attach a copy of an official receipt to the bid document when submitting as proof of payment. For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the North Eastern Supply Chain office before submitting the documents.**

Qualification for Tendering (Mandatory)

The bidders are expected to include the following in their bids:-

- ❖ Certified Copy of Certificate of incorporation;
- ❖ Certified Copy of VALID Registration Certificate with the National Construction Authority in the categories specified above and a Valid Practicing License;
- ❖ A copy of VALID Tax Compliance Certificate (Will be verified on the KRA TCC Checker);
- ❖ Certified Copy of RECENT CR12 form generated through the system -(6 months before bid opening date) from Registrar of Companies; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified;
- ❖ Bidders shall sequentially serialize all pages for each tender document submitted; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified;
- ❖ Certified copy of a valid certificate of registration in a target group issued by the National Treasury or the respective County Treasury in the relevant category (Youth, Women & PWD).

Note:

- ❖ Certification of documents shall be original and executed by a **Commissioner for Oaths or issuing institution**.
- ❖ Submitted Documents by the Bidders shall be subjected to **Due Diligence** from the originating sources and shall be used for recommendation or disqualifications depending on the outcome;
- ❖ All interested bidders are required to continually check the KURA website www.kura.go.ke/tenders for any tender addenda or clarification that may arise before the submission date.
- ❖ **COVID 19 Guidelines** from the Ministry Of Health shall apply during the tendering process.

- ❖ To enhance equity, bidders shall bid for a maximum of two (2) tenders pursuant to this tender notice. Bidding in more than two (2) tenders will result in disqualification.
- ❖ No bidder shall be awarded more than one tender as advertised in this notice.

The criteria of evaluation of bids

The criteria shall be as described in the tender documents.

Description of Works

The description and scope of works is as described in the tender documents.

Pre-Bid/Site visit

There shall be NO organized site visit. Bidders are however required to appraise themselves with the site conditions before bidding and complete the certificate of tenderers visit.

Bid Validity

Prices quoted should include all taxes and must be expressed in Kenya Shillings and shall remain valid for a period of 90 days from the date of tender opening.

Bid Submission

Completed tender documents enclosed in separate plain sealed envelopes and clearly marked with the respective Tender Number and Tender Name should be addressed and sent to:

Late bids will NOT be accepted.

Tenderers shall be invited to the meeting using the email addresses provided during bid submission.
