### TENDER NOTICE

The Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) is a State Corporation in the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, Housing, Urban Development and Public Works; established under Kenya Roads Act, 2007 with the core mandate of Management, Development, Rehabilitation and Maintenance of National Urban Road Network. As a leading Government Agency with the above mandate, KURA wishes to invite bids from eligible construction companies for road works as described below to be funded through the Government of Kenya - Development Vote.

Interested bidders **MUST** be registered with the National Construction Authority (NCA) road works categories as indicated below:-

Bidders may examine and obtain detailed tender documents during normal working hours, from the **Supply Chain Management Office on Ground floor Barabara plaza, Block D**, upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Kshs. 1,000 (Kenya Shillings One Thousand Only) for each document in form of a **Banker's Cheque** payable to the Kenya Urban Roads Authority. The same information may be accessed in websites at [www.kura.go.ke/tenders](http://www.kura.go.ke/tenders) and [www.tenders.go.ke](http://www.tenders.go.ke). Bidders will be required to attach a copy of an official receipt to the bid document when submitting as proof of payment. For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the Supply Chain Management office immediately after the site visit.

The bidders are expected to include the following in their bids:-

- ❖ Certified Copy of Certificate of incorporation;
- ❖ Certified Copy of VALID Registration Certificate with the National Construction Authority in the categories specified above and Valid Practicing License;
- ❖ A copy of VALID Tax Compliance Certificate (Will be verified on the KRA TCC Checker);
- ❖ Certified Copy of RECENT CR12 form generated through the system -(12 months before opening date) from Registrar of Companies; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified;
- ❖ Bidders shall sequentially serialize all pages for each tender document submitted; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified;

Note:

- ❖ Certification of documents shall be original and executed by a **Commissioner for Oaths or issuing institution**.
- ❖ Submitted Documents by the Bidders shall be subjected to **Due Diligence** from the originating sources and shall be used for recommendation or disqualifications depending on the outcome;
- ❖ All interested bidders are required to continually check the KURA website [www.kura.go.ke/tenders](http://www.kura.go.ke/tenders) for any tender addenda or clarification that may arise before the submission date.

**The criteria of evaluation of bids**

The criteria shall be as described in the tender document.

**Description of Works**

The description and scope of works is as described in the tender document.

Mandatory site visits/Pre-bid meeting shall be held on the date and time as per the schedule below, starting at the indicated places;

Bidders are required to be represented by a Technical person with Civil Engineering background who should come with a copy and Original of National Identification card or Passport, Copy of academic certificate and an Original introduction letter from the bidder (the letter should bear official Company letter head).

Prices quoted should include all taxes and must be expressed in Kenya Shillings and shall remain valid for a period of 120 days from the date of tender opening.


