TENDER NOTICE

The Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) is a State Corporation in the Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure (MOTI); established under Kenya Roads Act, 2007 with the core mandate of management, development, rehabilitation and maintenance of national urban road network. As a leading Government Agency with the above mandate, KURA wishes to invite bids from eligible construction companies for road works as described below to be funded through Road Maintenance Levy Fund (RMLF).

Interested bidders **MUST** be registered with the National Construction Authority (NCA) road works categories as indicated below:-

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and inspect tender documents from the Regional Supply Chain Management Department, Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) during normal working hours.

A complete set of tender documents may be obtained by interested tenderers from the Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) website: www.kura.go.ke or www.suppliers.treasury.go.ke. free of charge OR from the Regional Supply Chain Management Department, upon payment of a non- refundable fee of KShs. 1,000 (One thousand shillings only) in form of banker's Cheque only payable to Kenya Urban Roads Authority.

Bidders will be required to attach a copy of an official receipt to the bid document when submitting as proof of payment. For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the specific Regional Supply Chain Management Department immediately after the site visit and before submitting the documents.

Qualification for Tendering (Mandatory)

The bidders are expected to include the following in their bids:-

1. **Certified** copy of Certificate of incorporation
2. **Certified** Copy of a valid Registration certificate with National Construction Authority (NCA) in the relevant category and Practicing Licenses from NCA.
3. Copy of Valid Tax Compliance Certificate (will be verified on the KRA TCC Checker)
4. **Certified** copy of CR 12 form(Recent within 12 months)
5. Bidders shall **serialize** all pages for each tender document submitted; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified.
6. **Certified** copy of a valid certificate of registration in a target group issued by the National Treasury or the respective County Treasury in the relevant Category for those tenders reserved for Youth, Women and Persons with Disability.

Note:

- Certification of documents shall be original and executed by a **Commissioner for Oaths**.
- To enhance equity, Bidders shall bid for a maximum of **two (2)** tenders pursuant to this Tender Notice. Bidding in more than 2 tenders will result in disqualification.
- Bidders who have been awarded tenders by KURA for the financial year 2017-2018 are ineligible to bid.
- For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the **specific Regional Supply Chain Management Department** immediately after the site visit and before submitting the documents. **Failure to which bidders shall be disqualified.**
- No bidder shall be awarded more than one contract

Other Requirements are as specified in the respective tender documents.

Bid Price and Validity

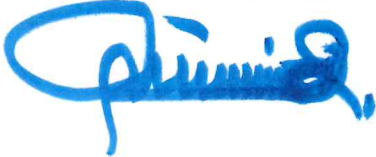
Prices quoted should include all taxes and must be expressed in Kenya Shillings and shall remain valid for a period of 90 days from the date of tender opening.

Completed tender documents enclosed in separate plain sealed envelopes and clearly marked with the Tender Number and Tender Name should be addressed and sent to the each region as indicated in the above table.

Tender documents can also be deposited in the Tender Box Situated in the Regional Offices as indicated in the table above so as to be received on or before 28th June, 2018 at 10.00am.

Tenders will be opened immediately thereafter in the presence of tenderers or their representatives who choose to attend. Late bids will not be accepted.
