TENDER NOTICE

The Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) is a State Corporation established under the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, Housing, Urban Development and Public works by the Kenya Roads Act, 2007 with the core mandate of Management, Development, Rehabilitation and Maintenance of all urban road's networks. As a leading Government Agency with the above mandate, KURA wishes to invite bids from eligible construction companies for road works as described below;

Interested bidders MUST be registered with the National Construction Authority in various categories as indicated below: -

Bidders may examine and obtain detailed tender documents during normal working hours, from the **Head Quarters Supply Chain Office Nairobi**, upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Kshs. 1,000** (Kenya Shillings One Thousand Only) for each document in form of a **Banker's Cheque** payable to the **Kenya Urban Roads Authority**. The same information may be accessed in websites at www.kura.go.ke/tenders, and www.tenders.go.ke. Bidders will be required to attach a copy of an official receipt to the bid document when submitting as proof of payment. For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the HQ Supply Chain office immediately after the site visit and before submitting the documents. No bidder shall be awarded more than one contract.

Qualification for Tendering (Mandatory)

The bidders are expected to include the following in their bids: -

- (a) **Certified copy of Certificate of incorporation;**
- (b) **Certified Copy of VALID Registration Certificate with the National Construction Authority in the classes specified above and valid Practicing License;**
- (c) **A copy of VALID Tax Compliance Certificate (Will be verified on the KRA TCC Checker)**
- (d) **Certified copy of system generated RECENT CR12 form -(12 months) from Registrar of Companies;**
- (e) **Bidders shall serialize all pages for each tender document submitted; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified.**

Note:

- The certification must be by a Commissioner for Oaths.
- Due diligence shall be carried out on the documents submitted by the bidders from the source of origin and the outcome shall be used for recommendation or disqualification.
- All Copies of documents submitted Must be legible and non- Legible documents shall not be considered

The criteria of evaluation of bids

The criteria shall be as described in the tender documents.

Description of Works

The description and scope of works is as described in the tender documents.
