TENDER NOTICE

The Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) is a State Corporation in the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, Housing, Urban Development and Public Works; established under Kenya Roads Act, 2007 with the core mandate of Management, Development, Rehabilitation and Maintenance of National Urban Road Network. As a leading Government Agency with the above mandate, KURA wishes to invite bids from eligible construction companies for road works as described below to be funded through Fuel Levy Fund (RMLF).

Interested bidders MUST be registered with the National Construction Authority (NCA) road works categories as indicated below:-

Bidders may examine and obtain detailed tender documents during normal working hours, from the Regional Supply Chain Office Central Region, upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Kshs. 1,000 (Kenya Shillings One Thousand Only) for each document in form of a **Banker's Cheque** payable to the **Kenya Urban Roads Authority**. The same information may be accessed in the websites at www.kura.go.ke/tenders and www.tenders.go.ke. Bidders will be required to attach a copy of an official receipt to the bid document when submitting as proof of payment. For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the Regional Supply Chain Office immediately after downloading and before submitting the documents.

The bidders are expected to include the following in their bids:-

- Certified Copy** of Certificate of incorporation;
- Certified Copy** of **VALID** Registration Certificate with the National Construction Authority in the categories specified above and Valid Practicing License;
- A copy** of **VALID** Tax Compliance Certificate (Will be verified on the KRA TCC Checker);
- Certified Copy** of **RECENT** CR12 form generated through the system -(6 months before opening date) from Registrar of Companies; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified;
- Bidders **shall sequentially serialize** all pages for each tender document submitted; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified;
- Certified copy** of a valid certificate of registration in a target group issued by the National Treasury or the respective County Treasury in the relevant category (**Youth, Women & PWD**).

Note:

- ❖ Certification of documents shall be original and executed by a **Commissioner for Oaths**.
- ❖ Submitted Documents by the Bidders **shall be subjected to Due Diligence** from the originating sources and shall be used for recommendation or disqualification depending on the outcome;
- ❖ All interested bidders are required to continually check the **KURA** website www.kura.go.ke/tenders for any addenda or clarification that may arise before the submission date.
- ❖ **COVID 19** Guidelines from the Ministry of Health shall apply during the tendering process.
- ❖ Bidders shall be awarded only one tender subject to this advertisement.
- ❖ For the purpose of equity prospective bidders are only allowed to participate in **2 (Two)** tenders pursuant to this Tender Notice. Participating in more than **2 (Two)** tenders will lead to disqualification.



The criteria of evaluation of bids

The criteria shall be as described in the tender documents.

Description of Works

The description and scope of works is as described in the tender documents.

Site Visits

There will be no organized site visits. Bidders are however required to appraise themselves with the site conditions before bidding.

Prices quoted should include all taxes, must be expressed in Kenya Shillings, and shall remain valid for a period of 210 days from the date of tender opening.
