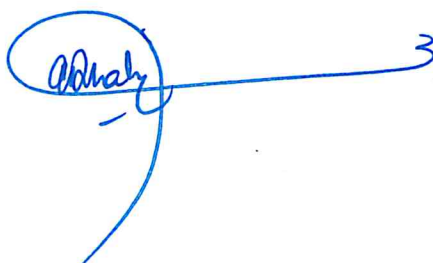

TENDER NOTICE

The Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) is a State Corporation in the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, Housing, Urban Development and Public Works; established under Kenya Roads Act, 2007 with the core mandate of Management, Development, Rehabilitation and Maintenance of National Urban Road Network. As a leading Government Agency with the above mandate, KURA wishes to invite bids from eligible construction companies for road works as described below to be funded through GOK BUDGET.

Interested bidders **MUST** be registered with the National Construction Authority (NCA) road works categories as indicated below:-

Bidders may examine and obtain detailed tender documents during normal working hours, from the **Supply Chain Management Office on Ground floor Barabara plaza, Block D**, upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Kshs. 1,000 (Kenya Shillings One Thousand Only) for each document in form of a **Banker's Cheque** payable to the **Kenya Urban Roads Authority**. The same information may be accessed in websites at www.kura.go.ke/tenders and www.tenders.go.ke. Bidders will be required to attach a copy of an official receipt to the bid document when submitting as proof of payment. For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the Supply Chain Management office (HQ) after visiting the site.

The bidders are expected to include the following in their bids:-

- ❖ **Certified Copy of Certificate of incorporation or equivalent for the Foreign Contractors.**
- ❖ **Certified Copy of VALID Registration Certificate with the National Construction Authority in the categories specified above and Valid Practicing License;**
- ❖ **A copy of VALID Tax Compliance Certificate (Will be verified on the KRA TCC Checker);**
- ❖ **Certified Copy of RECENT CR12 form generated through the system -(6 months before opening date) from Registrar of Companies; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified;**
- ❖ **Bidders shall sequentially serialize all pages for each tender document submitted; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified;**
- ❖ **All foreign contractors must enter into a Joint Venture JV with a Citizen Contractor where at least **Forty Percent** of work in terms of value shall be undertaken by a citizen contractor. A fully registered joint venture agreement executed according to the registration of documents acts must be submitted together with their tender, this requirement will form part of the tender;**
- ❖ **Preference and reservation for citizen contractors shall be implemented during evaluation as per the requirement of PPADA 2015 ACT and Regulation 2020 where the participation for the tender includes foreign contractors.**

Note:

- ❖ **Certification of documents shall be original and executed by a **Commissioner for Oaths** or issuing institution.**
- ❖ **Submitted Documents by the Bidders shall be subjected to Due Diligence from the originating sources and shall be used for recommendation or disqualifications depending on the outcome;**
- ❖ **All interested bidders are required to continually check the KURA website www.kura.go.ke/tenders for any tender addenda or clarification that may arise before the submission date.**
- ❖ **COVID 19 Guidelines from the Ministry Of Health shall apply during the tendering process.**
- ❖ **Bidders shall be awarded only one tender subject to this advertisement.**
- ❖ **For the purpose of equity and fairness KURA wishes to inform bidders that any bidder who was awarded a tender during the Financial Year 2020-2021 is ineligible to bid, Further bidders can only participate in 2(two) tenders pursuant to this Tender Notice.**
- ❖ **Eligibility by all contractors means the tender is open to the Citizen, Local and Foreign Contractors.**

The criteria of evaluation of bids

The criteria shall be as described in the tender document.

Description of Works

The description and scope of works is as described in the tender document.



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Site visits

There will be no organized site visit. Bidders are however required to appraise themselves with the site conditions before bidding. Each tenderer shall complete the Certificate of Tenderer's visit to the Site after voluntary Site visit.

Bid validity

Prices quoted should include all taxes and must be expressed in Kenya Shillings and shall remain valid for a period of 120 days from the date of tender opening.

Completed tender documents enclosed in separate plain sealed envelopes and clearly marked with the respective Tender Number and Tender Name should be addressed and sent to:

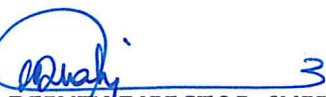
