TENDER NOTICE

The Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) is a State Corporation established under the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, Housing, Urban Development and Public Works established under Kenya Roads Act, 2007 with the core mandate of Management, Development, Rehabilitation and Maintenance national urban road network. As a leading Government Agency with the above mandate, KURA wishes to invite bids from eligible construction companies for road works as described below to be funded through Development Fund.

Interested bidders **MUST** be registered with the National Construction Authority (NCA) road works categories as indicated below: -

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and inspect tender documents from the **Supply Chain Management Department, Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA)** during normal working hours.

A complete set of tender documents may be obtained by interested tenderers from the Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) websites at www.kura.go.ke/tenders, or www.tenders.go.ke, free of charge or from the **Supply Chain Management Department**, upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Kshs. 1,000 (Kenya Shillings One Thousand Only) for each document in form of a **Banker's Cheque** payable to the **Kenya Urban Roads Authority**.

Bidders will be required to attach a copy of an official receipt to the bid document when submitting as proof of payment. For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the **Supply Chain Management Department** before submitting the documents.

The bidders shall include the following in their bids: -

- 1) **Certified Copy** of Certificate of incorporation
- 2) **Certified Copy** of VALID Registration Certificate with the National Construction Authority (NCA) in the relevant category and practicing licenses from NCA

- 3) A copy of VALID Tax Compliance Certificate (Will be verified on the KRA TCC Checker)
- 4) Certified copy of a system generated CR12 form (recent within (6 months before opening date)
- 5) Bidders shall sequentially serialize all pages for each tender document submitted failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified.
- 6) Certified copy of VALID certificate of registration in a target group issued by the National Treasury or the respective County Treasury in the relevant Category for those tenders reserved for Youth, Women and Persons with Disability.

Note:

- The certification of documents shall be original and executed by a **Commissioner for Oaths**.
- All interested bidders are required to continually check the KURA website www.kura.go.ke/tenders for any tender addendum or clarification that may arise before the submission date.
- Submitted documents by bidders shall be subjected to due diligence from the originating sources and shall be used for recommendations and disqualifications depending on the outcome.
- No bidder shall be awarded more than one contract pursuant to this tender notice.

Other requirements are specified in the respective Tender Document.

The criteria of evaluation of bids

The criteria shall be as described in the tender documents.

Description of Works

The description and scope of works is as described in the tender documents.

Site visits

There will be no organized site visit. Bidders are however required to appraise themselves with the site conditions before bidding. Each tenderer shall complete the Certificate of Tenderer's visit to the Site after voluntary Site visit.

Bid price and validity

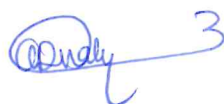
Prices quoted should include all taxes and must be expressed in Kenya Shillings and shall remain valid for a period of 210 days from the date of tender opening.

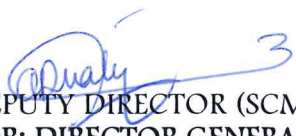
